What are the units covered in the Career Starter Course?

The three units covered in the course are taken from the TLI30319 Certificate III In Supply Chain Operations, they include: Apply knowledge of WHS Laws in the workplace, Shift Materials Safely using manual handling methods and Ensure the safety of Transport activities.

Among many other skills critical to the suitability for a specific job role, employers regard the above skills equally important when deciding on who to employ. Employers want people with these skills so that they can work effectively with the team in the organisation. Additionally, attending and participating in this course each day will provide opportunities for you to interact with the other students, and assists you to further develop your 'team interaction' skills, thus making you more employable to the employer.
